
The session progressed smoothly under the guidance of Sister Michelle Heckert, Sovereign Grand Master. Business was transacted daily with a few code changes and updates.


Wednesday night, our own Brother PSGM George L. Glover, III; had the privilege of installing the Sovereign Grand Master, Brother John
